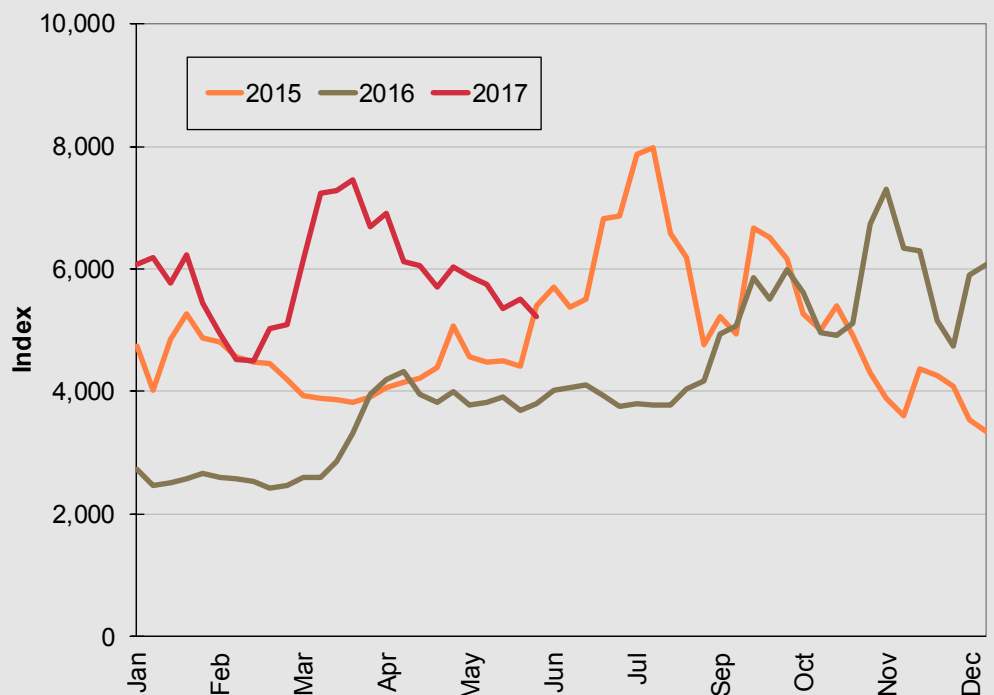
The SSY Atlantic Capesize Index retreated by 269 points last week to 5,229 points. Over-supplied ballasting vessels helped to drag fronthaul rates for 180 kdwT vessels down by \$1,500/day to \$19,500/day, the lowest level since early March. There was a smaller \$750/day decline in the Atlantic round voyage rate to \$9,100/day.

The Atlantic Capesize Index started at 5,000 points on 2 October 1989 and has since been subject to periodic updating to reflect changing trade patterns. The latest update was on 17 July 2015.
